

# Simple Steps to Help Keep Our City Clean!!!

## **Street Department:**

**Will** pick up yard waste, but yard waste must be separate from household garbage/trash.  
Yard waste and some trash is picked up by the Street Department on alternate weeks.

**Will not** pickup Contractor's Material. It is the responsibility of the property owner or resident to dispose of this kind of debris.

**Home Owners who live at the property** – Contact the Street Department at 948-5352 when you have items to pick up and upon inspection they will determine if the items can be picked up.

**Will** only pickup leafs in bags! (Do not blow leaves into the streets or curbs. These will not be picked up!)

**Violation(s) of any of the above may be subject to fines!!!**

## **Traffic Division:**

Cars parked on the street over 24 hours will be ticketed and/or towed!

**NO** parking in the front, side or rear yards! **NO** parking on sidewalks or tree lawns (the grass between the sidewalk and street)! **NO** blocking of private driveways!

**These are all \$50 fines.**

Vehicles that can not be parked on city streets:

- 1.) Semi- trucks or other commercial vehicles.
- 2.) An vehicle(s) with declared gross weight of 26,000 pds or exceeding 25 ft in Length

**These are \$75 fines!!!**

### **Abandoned Vehicle(s):**

- A vehicle located on public property illegally.
- A vehicle that has remained on private property without consent of the property owner.
- A vehicle at least 3 model years old, mechanically inoperable and is left on private property continuously in a location visible from public view for more than 20 days.

Any of these violations can result in the vehicle being towed.

## **Other Ordinances:**

### **High Grass and Weeds:**

9" inches or taller is in violation. If the Grass and Weed Maintenance Department cuts the grass and/or weeds, you will be billed !!!

**No** posting of signs (yard sale signs or any temporary signs) in public right of way!

**Sanitation:**

**Residential Solid Waste:**

- \*Garbage
- \*Refuse
- \*Trash – Generated by residents occupying the residential units.  
This includes 1 bulk item per pickup. Garbage/trash must be set out by 7 a.m..  
Garbage cans should be 40 lbs max. (1 can - 4 or 5 bags)

Residential Waste – One Pickup a week

Recyclables – Two times a month

City **NO** longer supplies garbage cans to residents. Residents will need to purchase their own cans (40 lb max)  
(Echo-Tech has the garbage cans that we presently use for \$80.00)

**Unacceptable Waste (Will not be picked up)**

- \*Hazardous Material
- \*Asphalt
- \*Iron
- \*Automobile/Truck Parts and Tires
- \*Other refuses from repairs, alterations or new construction
- \*Any Remodeling Debris
- \*Dirt
- \*Gravel\*Concrete
- \*Hot Ashes
- \*Broken or Whole Bricks
- \*No Yard Waste
- \*Stones
- \*Steel
- \*Liquids of any kind – inflammable and/or explosive

<p>Plastic: Soda, milk ,shampoo and small-mouth bottles marked #1 through #7. Please rinse and flatten!</p>	<p>Plastic: Bottle caps or Styrofoam, margarine or desert tubs, plastic bags of any type, motor oil containers, fast food containers and cups</p>
<p>Glass: Clear, brown, green and blue glass bottles and jars in which food products are packaged. Please rinse!</p>	<p>Glass: Plastic or metal lids, drinking glasses,, light bulbs, broken glass or window panes</p>
<p>Paper: White paper: computer or copy paper: white paper tablets Folders: Manila or colored Mail: letter, brochures, advertisements, magazines up to one inch thick Shredded paper: place in clear plastic bag Newspaper: include inserts Paperboard: cereal, cake mix, cracker boxes, beverage boxes, gift boxes</p>	<p>Paper: Pizza boxes, milk cartons, wax coated beverage containers, paper napkins or facial tissues, paper plates and cups, books-hard cover or paperback, Styrofoam egg cartons</p>
